City Coach Service

Provides public transportation within Vacaville City limits. Printed schedules are available on the buses and at most City buildings.

The fixed routes provide hourly service from the downtown transfer point at Bank of America on Kendal Street and from Ulatis Cultural Center to different areas of Vacaville.

No Service on Sundays and observed holidays (New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, or Christmas Day). Saturday service will be provided the day following Thanksgiving.

Special Services (Dial-A-Ride)

Provides door-to door service for individuals who are unable to independently ride fixed route buses due to a disability. To be considered for Special Services, call **449-5170** and an application will be mailed to you. You will need to explain how your disability prevents you from using fixed route service. Certification for use of Special Services may require a doctor's verification.

How long does certification take?

A determination of eligibility will be made within 21 days. Applications that are not complete will be returned.

Subsidized Taxi Program

Persons certified for Special Services and anyone over 60 may purchase Taxi Scrip and save 50% off the cost of taxi service. Scrip may be purchased at City Hall, the McBride Senior Center, and the Ulatis Cultural Center.
