








Overall Job Rating for Vacaville City Government in Providing Services to People Who Live Here





6 Most Serious Problems Facing Vacaville Today




Seriousness of 7 Other Problems Facing Vacaville Today










Job Rating for How City Council Has Handled Budget Deficits










Votes on Possible November Ballot Measures




5 Votes On Continuing Measure I




Cuts That **DEFINITELY SHOULD NOT** Be Made Without Measure I Funds
