SIX ARRESTED IN SERIES OF SEX OFFENDER COMPLIANCE CHECKS

Six people were arrested for violating the terms of their parole or probation during a sweep of sex offenders that took place Wednesday.

Detectives from the Family Investigative Response Services Team (F.I.R.S.T.) and Investigative Services Section (ISS) of the Vacaville Police Department, officers from the Solano County Probation Department, California Department of Corrections and Parole, United States Federal Marshal agents from the Sacramento Division, and detectives from Dixon Police Department conducted 44 individual 290 offender (sex offender) compliance checks throughout the cities of Vacaville and Dixon. The offenders were identified as being on probation or parole for various sex crimes, identified as sexually violent predators, or being on probation or parole for crimes that included possession of child pornography.

During this compliance check operation, the various agencies involved arrested the above mentioned individuals for various violations. All six were booked into Solano County Jail.

The Vacaville Police Department routinely coordinates and conducts probation and parole checks on offenders identified to be on active probation or parole. In addition to those being on probation or parole, the Department also contacts individuals required to register as sex offenders in our community to ensure they are also in compliance.

The Vacaville Police Department maintains a "zero-tolerance" policy while conducting these checks and encourages individuals to abide by the terms of their probation or parole.
