Narrative:

On July 4, 2012 at 11:56 p.m., the Vacaville Communication Center received a medical call of a man down in the street on Garden Circle. Police and fire units responded to the scene and found a male subject unconscious in the street suffering from a head injury. The subject was transported to a local hospital for treatment.

A large 4th of July celebration was taking place in the street with an estimated 200 people attending at the time of this incident. Patrol Officers attempted to locate a witness who saw how the subject was injured but were unsuccessful in gaining any information at this time.

The victim had suffered a major injury to his head that required him to be transported by helicopter to a trauma center for further treatment. His condition has been described as very serious and life threatening. The victim has had surgery to relieve swelling of his brain and is improving.

Police have learned that the victim was struck in the head at least one time by a male subject on Garden Circle. Detectives from the Investigative Services Section (ISS) have assumed this investigation and additional leads are being follow-up on.

The Vacaville Police had three separate violent incidents on July 4, 2012, two stabbings and this serious injury assault. All three incidents occurred in close proximity in the same neighborhood and within a seven hour time period. At this time police do not believe that these cases are related.
