POLICE ARREST THREE IN JEWELRY STORE ROBBERY; THREE MORE SOUGHT

Vacaville police have arrested three suspects in a brazen Thursday mid-morning robbery of a jewelry store in downtown Vacaville involving at least six men wielding a handgun and hammers.

At approximately 10:59 a.m., police began receiving numerous 9-1-1 calls of a robbery at the DeBartolo Jewelry Store located at 528 Main Street in Vacaville. Patrol units and detectives responded to the scene.

According to witnesses, as many as six masked men exited a black Dodge Magnum, California License 6NKP418, parked on Main Street and entered the jewelry store. The suspects were described as black male adults, approximately 6 feet tall, wearing dark colored or black clothing. Witnesses told officers the suspects were carrying duffel bags and hammers as they entered the store, and one of the suspects was armed with a black handgun.

The suspects entered the store and confronted a lone employee inside. One suspect held the victim at gunpoint as the others smashed out glass displays and took merchandise. The suspects were seen fleeing in the area in the same Dodge Magnum.

A short time later a Vacaville police officer saw the suspect vehicle westbound on I-80 approaching Fairfield. The vehicle was followed until additional units could safely make a vehicle stop. A high-risk stop was conducted and three subjects were detained in the vehicle.

Detectives arrested S-Adrian Landers and S-Derrick McCann. Both suspects are 18 years old and from San Francisco. They were booked into Solano County Jail in Fairfield on robbery charges. A 16-year-old male was also taken into custody and booked into Juvenile Hall in Solano County.
