RESIDENT INTERRUPTS RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY; THREE ARRESTED

Police arrested three suspects in a home burglary after a resident returning home from work saw the suspects inside the home and contacted police.

At approximately 7:53 p.m. on November 9, 2012, a resident in the 1000 block of Marshall Road returned home from work and spotted a car she did not recognize in front of her home as well as two people she did not know inside the home. She drove to a safe location and called police to report the situation.

Prior to officers arriving, one suspect in a gray Dodge Charger fled the scene. Officers arrived and surrounded the home, while other officers were looking for the Dodge Charger.

Upon entering the home, officers and a K-9 unit found four people in the home – two suspects and two other friends of the resident who had arrived to confront the suspects after being called by the resident.

The two suspects were identified as committing the burglary and detained. Officers arrested Vacaville residents S- Bradley Dinsmore, 29; and S-Lori Peranzo, 29. Officers will seek an additional charge of providing false information to the police by S-Peranzo.

A Vacaville police officer located the fleeing vehicle at the intersection of Beelard Drive and Elmira Road. The car was stopped in the 100 block of Santana Drive. Officers arrested the driver of the car who was identified as Vacaville resident S-Marissa Stouffer, 29.

The three suspects were booked into the Solano County Jail without incident.

Officers recovered all of the stolen property from the residence. The Vacaville Police Department's partnership with the Vacaville community enabled this case to come to a successful resolution without further property loss or injury.
