VACAVILLE POLICE ARREST PROWLER IN POSSESSION OF BURGLARY TOOLS

On Wednesday, November 28, 2012, Vacaville Police Officers arrested a local man after they found a bag containing a variety of burglary tools in his possession.

Officers were investigating a report of a man seen lurking around homes in the 900 block of Scottsdale Drive. Officers arrived in the area and saw S-Gary Bernardo, 45, of Vacaville looking into vehicles at one of the homes. Officers detained S-Bernardo and found a bag containing burglary tools under his jacket. S-Bernardo could not provide a legal reason for being on the property with the burglary tools.

S-Bernardo was arrested for prowling and possession of the burglary tools. S-Bernardo told Officers that when he got out of jail, he was going to harm them; he was subsequently charged with making threats to peace officers and was booked into Solano County Jail in Fairfield.

The Vacaville Police Department's partnership with the Vacaville community enabled this case to come to a successful resolution without property loss or injury.
