Narrative:

On November 19, 2012 at approximately 4:20 p.m., the Vacaville Communications Center received a 9-1-1 call of a shooting in the 100 block of Calle Tepic, The El Matador Trailer Park. Patrol Officers responded to the scene and contacted a male caller who said that a friend had just shot himself inside his trailer. Officers entered the trailer and found an unresponsive 19 year old male suffering from a single gunshot wound to the head.

Vacaville Fire Paramedics responded to the scene but were unsuccessful with attempts to revive the victim. V- Ernesto Castillo Jr., 19 years of Vacaville, was pronounced dead at the scene. Patrol officers secured the home and detectives from the Investigative Services Section were called out to take over the investigation.

Detectives suspected early on that this was not a suicide and that witnesses were not being honest and forthcoming with information relating to the shooting. The investigation was treated as a homicide and more resources were brought in to assist.

The investigation continued over the next several days and confirmed this was not a suicide, nor was it a self-inflicted gun shot wound. S-Roberto Revelo of Fairfield was identified as a suspect and police began searching for him.

On November 23, 2012 at approximately 4:10 p.m., Detectives saw S-Revelo in the 1900 block of Grande Circle in Fairfield. He was taken into custody without incident and ultimately transported to the Solano County jail. S-Revelo was booked on the charge of murder.

Detectives do not believe this crime was gang related at this time. The case is being forwarded to the District Attorney's Office for review. The investigation is ongoing and detectives are seeking for more details from anyone with information relating to the Monday afternoon shooting.
