### **Out-of-Town Criminals Captured in Vacaville**

In the early morning of February 11, 2013, Officer Over was on patrol when he noticed a Toyota Corolla on Nut Tree Road. Upon spotting Officer Over, the occupants in the Corolla began acting strange and rapidly tried to get out of Officer Over's view. This behavior caught Officer Over's attention and he followed the vehicle.

Officer Over discovered the license plate on the Corolla had been reported stolen. Officer Over stopped the vehicle and contacted three occupants. The driver, S-Manuel Ortiz, was found to be on probation out of Santa Clara County. S-Jobina Villarreal was on probation out of San Joaquin County for auto theft. S-Ray Ramos had been sentenced to prison, but had been released on Post Release Community Supervision (PRCS).

The Registered Owner of the vehicle was not one of the occupants and none of the occupants could explain who the car belonged to. Police dispatchers contacted family members of the registered owner and learned the vehicle had been stolen in Sacramento. The stolen license plate on the Corolla has been stolen off a Toyota in San Jose.

All three were arrested for possessing the stolen car. S-Ortiz, the driver, was also charged for auto theft.

After S-Ramos' arrest a counterfeit \$20.00 bill was found in his pocket. He was also charged for possessing the counterfeit bill and for violating his PRCS terms.

During a search of S-Villarreal a glass pipe that had been used to smoke methamphetamine was found hidden on her person. She was also charged with Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia.

All three suspects were booked into the Solano County Jail. Information of this arrest will be forwarded to the counties where they are on probation or PRCS.
