Vacaville man in critical condition after motorcycle collides into big rig

On February 14, 2013 at 12:27 p.m., the Vacaville Police Department Communication's Center received calls regarding a collision between a motorcyclist and big rig on Nut Tree Road at Fairview Drive. The motorcyclist was reported to be down on the ground unconscious with labored breathing. Police and Fire personnel arrived on scene and found the motorcyclist, a 36 year old Vacaville male was suffering from severe head trauma. His name is not being released at this time pending notification of next of kin.

An air ambulance was requested. The male was transported via ground ambulance to Kaiser Vacaville and once stabilized then flown via air ambulance to Kaiser Hospital in South Sacramento. At the time of this press release, the male was listed in critical condition and undergoing emergency surgery. Both north and southbound Nut Tree lanes between Bel Air Drive and Alamo Drive were closed for approximately three hours while Traffic Officers conducted their investigation.

A preliminary investigation revealed the big rig truck was being driven by 58 year old Sacramento resident Rickie Williams. He was in the left hand turn pocket of northbound Nut Tree Road to make a turn into the rear lot of Raley's grocery store. The unidentified motorcyclist was traveling southbound in the number one lane of Nut Tree Road approaching the Raley's driveway. The big rig driver made the left turn and the motorcyclist was unable to stop in time and collided with the big rig. Alcohol or drugs were not found to be a factor in this collision.
