



**PUBLIC UTILITY COMPANIES  
GENERAL PERMIT RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Temporary surfacing of asphalt concrete cut back shall be placed the same day as backfilling is completed.
2. Barricades must be kept on all trenches, excavations, and obstructions. Lights must be maintained at night. All warning and safety devices shall conform to the current manual of warning signs, lights and other devices for use in performance of work upon highways, as issued by the State of California Department of Transportation.
3. Access to fire hydrants shall be maintained at all times. Access to adjacent property shall be provided.
4. The use of flagmen is mandatory where the one, two-way vehicular traffic has less than twenty-four feet width in which to pass; or, (2) where vehicular traffic must pass to the left of dividing islands in passing the site of the encroachment. Closing of streets requires the approval of the Director of Public Works.
5. Applicants must obtain all other permits required by other public or private agencies or individuals necessary in order to perform the intended work. If this provision is not complied with, this permit shall be null and void. It shall be the responsibility of the applicant to notify USA and any other utility companies including cable TV before starting any construction that may involve their underground or overhead facilities.
6. Applicant shall indemnify and save harmless the City of Vacaville, its officers and agents, from all suits or actions of every name and description, brought for, or on account of any injuries or damages received or sustained by any person or persons, by or from the applicant, his servants or agents, in the construction of the work or by or in consequence of any negligence in guarding the same, or for improper materials used in its construction.
7. The permittee is responsible for the maintenance and repair of encroachment for a period of two years after acceptance by the City.
8. The permittee agrees to pay all costs if any portion of this permit is not complied with and if the City is required to perform any maintenance or safety measures.
