JOINT OPERATION RESULTS IN FOUR ARRESTS ON DRUG CHARGES

A joint effort between police agencies in Solano and Napa counties Thursday afternoon resulted in the arrest of four Vallejo residents on a variety of drug charges.

At about 1:30 p.m. Thursday, January 24, 2013, the Vacaville Police Department Narcotics Enforcement Team (NET) and Crime Suppression Team (CST), along with officers from the Fairfield Police Department, Solano County Sheriff's Department, Solano California Methamphetamine Enforcement Team and Napa Police Department served six narcotics-related search warrants at six separate residences in Vallejo and Napa, with five of the search warrants being served in Vallejo.

Prior to the service of the search warrants, the Vacaville CST Team conducted a traffic stop on S-Jose Patino, 42, of Vallejo in the City of Vacaville. S-Patino was detained without incident and found with a large amount of cash.

S-Graciela Villa, 34, of Vallejo was contacted at her residence in the 100 block of Franklin Street in Vallejo, where approximately ½ pound of suspected methamphetamine with an estimated street value of \$17,000 and a total of over \$23,000 in cash was seized. During the service of the six search warrants, additional methamphetamine, a firearm and evidence of drug sales was located.



S-Patino was booked into the Solano County Jail for conspiracy, possession of methamphetamine, and possession of a controlled substance while driving a motor vehicle; S-Graciela Villa was booked for conspiracy, and possession of methamphetamine; S-David Vasquez, 61, of Vallejo was arrested and booked for conspiracy, possession of methamphetamine and possession of drug paraphernalia, while S-Martin Gonzalez Villa was booked for an outstanding arrest warrant.
