On March 28, 2013 at approximately 8:39 a.m., the Vacaville Police Department Communications Center received a call from a concerned citizen advising of two suspicious subjects that were in the backyard of a residence. The subjects, later identified as S-Aaron Aimison and S-Gerell Edwards, were not the homeowners and were not known in the area. While officers were en route, the citizen advised the subjects forced open a back window and entered the home.

Officers arrived within a few minutes and began to set up a perimeter. Both suspects suddenly fled from the rear of the residence, jumping fences and running eastbound. Both suspects were caught by officers and detectives a short distance from the residence.

Officers found a rear window had been forced open and the home had been ransacked. The owner of the residence was located and responded. The owner confirmed the forced entry into the home and that his house had been ransacked, however, he did not locate anything missing.

Both suspects were booked into Solano County Jail for 459 PC/residential burglary, 182 PC/conspiracy, and 148 PC/resist, obstruct officers.
