VACAVILLE TEACHER ARRESTED ON CAMPUS ON DRUG, GUN CHARGES

On Thursday, Vacaville police arrested a Vacaville middle school teacher after finding drugs and a loaded firearm in his vehicle on campus grounds.

A credible source contacted Willis Jepson Middle School officials on Thursday and told them that S-Bobby Chambers, 53, of Chico and a teacher at the school, had a loaded weapon and marijuana in his vehicle, which was parked on school grounds.

A Vacaville Police Youth Services officer was contacted by school officials and began an investigation into the matter. S-Chambers was contacted and consented to a search of his vehicle. During the search, officers found a loaded handgun, cocaine, less than one ounce of marijuana, and additional ammunition in the vehicle.

S-Chambers was arrested without incident and booked into the Solano County Jail on a variety of drug and gun charges.
