POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS TEAM UP FOR FIREWORKS ENFORCEMENT

The City of Vacaville wants all of our residents to enjoy a safe, fun Fourth of July, as well as remind everyone that all forms of fireworks are illegal in the City, including so-called "safe and sane" fireworks.

An enforcement team comprised of Vacaville police and firefighters will be focusing their efforts on dangerous fireworks throughout the City over the Fourth of July holiday. Dangerous fireworks include aerial shells, sky rockets, bottle rockets, and other illegal fireworks. These fireworks are the cause of many fires in Solano County and will not be tolerated in the City of Vacaville.

Persons in possession of illegal fireworks are subject to arrest. The type of firework possessed will determine if the offense is a misdemeanor or felony.

If you would like to enjoy fireworks, the City of Vacaville is hosting a free 4th of July Celebration, which will be held at the Creekwalk/Andrews Park. Park gates will open at 5:00 p.m. and music will start at 6:30 p.m. Food and craft vendors will be on site. A fireworks display will cap the evening beginning at approximately 9:20 p.m.
