Police Motorcycle Pursuit Ends With Two Juveniles in Custody

On 08/05/13 at approximately 4:20 p.m., a Vacaville Police Sergeant was on patrol when she spotted a small motorcycle (dirt bike) traveling on Nut Tree Road. The motorcycle was occupied by two males, neither wearing a helmet.

The occupants immediately observed the Sergeant and they sped away. A 1.6 mile pursuit ensued. The rider failed to stop at stop signs at intersections, drove on the wrong side of the street, and even drove through a neighborhood park while being pursued. The driver attempted to make a left turn onto Raleigh Drive from Caldwell Drive, but failed to complete the turn, striking the curb. Both males abandoned the crashed motorcycle and fled on foot. With the assistance of more police officers, both males were arrested within minutes of the crash.

Further investigation revealed the motorcycle was stolen from the garage of a Vacaville residence. The passenger was cited and released for resisting arrest and the driver was booked into Solano County Juvenile Hall on charges of Residential Burglary, Vehicle Theft, Felony Evading, and Driving Unlicensed.
