DUI Checkpoint Nets 25 Arrests

Vacaville, CA – The Vacaville Police Department Traffic Unit conducted a DUI/Drivers License checkpoint on September 1, 2013 on northbound Allison Drive between Ulatis Drive and Travis Way from the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 12:00 a.m. Checkpoints are placed in locations that have the greatest opportunity for achieving drunk and drugged driving deterrence and provide the greatest safety for officers and the public.

This DUI/Drivers License checkpoint lowers DUI deaths and injuries. A major component of these checkpoints is the deterrent effects it has on those who might drive drunk or drugged impaired bring about more awareness and encouraging everyone to use sober designated drivers.

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), checkpoints have provided the most effective documented results of any of the DUI enforcement strategies, while also yielding considerable cost savings of \$6 for every \$1 spent.

- [534] Vehicles Screened
- [1] DUI-Alcohol suspect arrested
- [23] Drivers cited/arrested for operating a vehicle unlicensed or while suspended/revoked
- [1] Subject arrested on an outstanding misdemeanor warrant
