SEARCH WARRANT IN ELMIRA LEADS TO DRUGS, WEAPONS, CASH

An investigation by the Vacaville Police Department led to the discovery of a variety of drugs, weapons, cash and stolen items at a home in Elmira Thursday morning.

On December 19, 2013 at about 7:30 a.m. the Vacaville Police Department's Narcotics Enforcement Team (NET) served a search warrant in the 6000 block of Chicorp Lane in Elmira. During the service of the warrant, officers located approximately 26 pounds of marijuana, evidence of marijuana sales, a small amount of methamphetamine, ammunition, several long rifles, one handgun, approximately \$10,000 in cash and stolen property. Three adults, S-Delmacio Fernandez, 30, S-Viola Gonzales, 60, and S-Virginia Lomeli, 31, all of Elmira, were at the home during the search and detained without incident. A 13-year-old child was also at home and was taken into protective custody.

Three adult pit bull dogs and three pit bull puppies were taken by Humane Animal Services (HAS) to a safe location.

S-Fernandez, S-Gonzales and S-Lomeli were arrested and booked into the Solano County Jail in Fairfield on a variety of charges, including possession of marijuana for sale, possession of a controlled substance, committing a crime while out on bail, violation of probation, possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, possession of a firearm while on probation, person prohibited from possessing ammunition, possession of stolen property, and threatening a police officer.
