### **VACAVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT ARREST THEFT SUSPECTS**

On Friday evening, January 24, 2014, Vacaville Police arrested two suspects after they allegedly took property without paying for it from the Vacaville Premium Outlets and Solano Town Center in Fairfield.

A store employee at Hartstrings Outlet Store, a retailer located at the Outlets, informed police that two individuals were seen taking property without paying for the items. Officers confronted the suspects about stolen merchandise as they were leaving Charlotte Russe, a clothing retail store also at the Vacaville Premium Outlets. The two suspects were immediately taken into custody by officers.

Officers located a vehicle that was driven by one of the suspects and a search of the vehicle revealed stolen merchandise from Hartstrings, Charlotte Russe, Sanrio, Bath and Body Works, Timberland and Crazy 8 in the Vacaville Premium Outlet Stores.

Officers also recovered stolen merchandise from the Disney Store, Gymboree, Child's Place and New York & Company in the Solano Town Mall in Fairfield. The stolen merchandise was valued in excess of \$3,583.00.
