### **Narrative:**

On June 19, 2014, at approximately 3:12 a.m., the Vacaville Police Department received an alarm call for the Mexico Meat Market located at 1030 East Monte Vista Avenue. The officers responded within minutes and found the front window of the store had been broken. S-Todd Sampson was seen exiting the store upon the officers arrival. K-9 Officer Darren Young and K-9 Syar were deployed and subsequently took S-Sampson into custody after a short foot pursuit. The suspect was interviewed and indicated there were additional suspects still inside the store and were possibly armed.

The officers on scene secured the perimeter of the store and our SWAT team was called to the scene. For public safety and scene security, a portion of East Monte Vista Avenue had to be shut down for a short period of time. The Yolo County Bomb Squad was called and provided equipment to assist with the search of the business. The SWAT team searched the store and did not locate any additional suspects. Upon further review of video surveillance, our investigators discovered S-Sampson was the sole suspect in the case. S-Sampson was treated for minor wounds from K-9 Syar and transported to county jail.
