### **INTERRUPTED BUCK AVENUE BURGLARY SENDS PAIR TO JAIL**

An early-morning attempted burglary ended with two suspects in jail and the items taken during the burglary recovered.

Early Sunday morning at around 1 a.m., a Vacaville resident heard prowlers inside a garage and called police. The first officers on the scene saw a woman running between residences in the 300 block of Buck Avenue. Officers pursued on foot and the woman was quickly apprehended.

An inspection of the garage where the prowlers were heard revealed damage at an open garage door and contents inside the garage strewn about. A car inside the garage had been tampered with. Items from inside the garage forged a path to where the female suspect was seen running and where two bicycles had been discarded.

Officers continued searching the area for any additional suspects. During the search the front door to a residence in the 300 block of Buck Avenue was found kicked open.

Police K-9 Syar was called to the scene and the canine began looking for the outstanding suspect. While this search was being completed, another suspect, a male, was caught by officers as he was trying to sneak out of the area.

Police arrested S-Michael Doyle, 27, of Vacaville and S-Tona White, 28, of Vacaville on charges of burglary and conspiracy. S-Doyle was also charged with attempted auto theft and being in violation of the terms of his probation.

S-White was found with stolen property, methamphetamine and methamphetamine paraphernalia in her possession. As a result, S-White was charged with possession of stolen property; possession of methamphetamine; and possession of methamphetamine paraphernalia in addition to being charged with burglary and conspiracy.

Both S-Doyle and S-White were booked into Solano County Jail. All of the stolen property in this case was recovered.
