SUSPECTS ARRESTED FOR THEFTS AT THE FACTORY STORES

On Friday, November 28, 2014 at about 5:23 p.m., officers were dispatched to the Vacaville Premium Outlets for a theft in progress. Officers detained S-Tristan Love, a 19 year old Vacaville resident. A store manager told responding officers he witnessed S-Love take property from his store. In addition to stolen property, S-Love was in possession of a small amount of suspected black tar heroin, drug paraphernalia, burglary tools, and counterfeit currency. S-Love was transported to the Solano County Jail where he was subsequently released after being cited for the aforementioned misdemeanor violations.

In an unrelated and second theft incident, shortly after S-Love was arrested, a customer of the Factory Stores saw two people removing property from his car. The alert citizen was able to provide the license plate number of the suspects' car to police dispatch. An officer from the Vacaville Police Department spotted the car on I-80 westbound near Pena Adobe. Moments later, officers from Vacaville and the CHP stopped the car near Travis Blvd., in Fairfield. Officers found the victim's property along with hundreds of dollars worth of additional suspected stolen property and counterfeit currency.

Officers arrested S-Calvin Willform, a 26 year old Vallejo resident, and S-Antonia Williams, a 29 year old San Francisco resident, for burglary, possession of stolen property, possession of counterfeit currency, and conspiracy. Also, S-Willform had a felony warrant for his arrest issued by Sacramento County for burglary in that jurisdiction.

Both S-Willform and S-Williams were booked into the Solano County Jail.
