SACRAMENTO TRIO ARRESTED AT PREMIUM OUTLETS WITH DRUGS

Vacaville police arrested a trio of Sacramento residents after discovering they were in possession of drugs and providing false names to officers.

On Tuesday, December 2, 2014 at 9:00 p.m., a Community Services Officer from the Vacaville Police Department saw a suspicious vehicle speeding through a parking lot of the Vacaville Premium Outlets. The occupants of the vehicle parked the car and were acting suspiciously in the area as well.

Officers responded and found the vehicle, a white Isuzu Rodeo SUV, parked near the Michael Kors store. Upon contacting the occupants, officers quickly learned they were not in the area for business. S-William French, 47, of Sacramento was arrested for possession of methamphetamine and possession of drug paraphernalia. S-Cecelia Peralez, 28, of Sacramento originally gave a false name to conceal the fact that she was wanted out of Placer County on two No Bail warrants for sales and/or transportation of a controlled substance. S-Peralez was booked on the warrants as well as the new charges that included possession of drug paraphernalia and lying about her identity. S-Scott Risse, 57, of Sacramento was arrested for drug paraphernalia and was also wanted on a No Bail warrant for a California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation parole hold. Photos of S-Risse and S-Peralez are included with this release. French's photo was not available.

A subsequent search of their vehicle revealed a catalytic converter and cutting tools inside the SUV, though the catalytic converter could not be tied to any of the recent thefts from the area.

The City of Vacaville has been plagued by a rash a catalytic converter thefts from a multitude of vehicles in commercial parking lots and residential neighborhoods. If you see suspicious activity occurring beneath or around vehicles please contact the Vacaville Police Department at 707-449-5200.
