UPDATE – POLICE ARREST SUSPECT IN NOV. 26 STABBING CASE

Vacaville police have arrested a suspect in a stabbing that took place November 26, 2014 while the victim was at work.

Members of the Vacaville Police Department Crime Supression Team arrested S-Daniel Carranza, 19, of Vacaville Wednesday afternoon. S-Carranza is suspected of stabbing a co-worker while at work in the 900 block of Aldridge Drive. The attack is believed to be gang-related. A \$150,000 arrest warrant had been issued for S-Carranza. A photo of S-Carranza is attached. The victim was stabbed multiple times and is still recovering in the hospital.

At about 3:30 p.m. Wednesday, detectives observed S-Carranza riding in a Jeep on Elmira Road. S-Carranza was arrested during a traffic stop on Woodridge Drive at Nut Tree Road.

A search warrant was served at S-Carranza's residence, where potential evidence was located and seized. S-Carranza was booked at Solano County Jail on charges of attempted murder, assault with a deadly weapon, probation violation, and committing a crime while being out on bail for another crime.

POLICE SEEK SUSPECT IN WEDNESDAY STABBING OF WORKER

Vacaville police are looking for the person or persons responsible for stabbing a man while he was working late Wednesday evening

On November 26, 2014, officers responded to the above location for a report of a stabbing that had just occurred. Officers located a male victim who had been stabbed multiple times while he was working. Other employees administered initial first aid for the victim until paramedics arrived. The victim was taken to a local hospital for treatment. At the time of this press release the victim was still being treated.
