VACAVILLE POLICE ARREST SUSPECT IN FAIRFIELD CAR THEFT


Vacaville police arrested a Fairfield man on Tuesday as he attempted to drive away from a local store in a stolen vehicle.

At about 6:30 p.m. Tuesday, officers in the area of the 800 block of Markham Avenue spotted a Chrysler 300 sedan that had been reported stolen from the City of Fairfield on December 15, 2014.

The vehicle was parked in front of a liquor store and appeared to be occupied and running with the lights on. Officers watched a man walk out of the liquor store and get into the driver's seat of the stolen vehicle. Before he was able to leave the vehicle or the parking lot, officers, with assistance from the Solano County Sheriff's Office, block all avenues of escape.

Police then arrested S-Joseph Galloway, 24, of Petaluma without incident for possession of the stolen vehicle and an unrelated \$10,000 warrant out of Sonoma County. An unidentified female in the front passenger seat was detained and released from the scene. A photo of S-Galloway is included.
