POLICE ARREST SUSPECT IN RADIO SHACK ARMED ROBBERY

Vacaville police have arrested a suspect in the robbery of the Radio Shack that occurred on January 15, 2015. The original press release regarding that incident is included below.

During the course of this investigation, Police learned S-Raymond Menefee, 38 of Vacaville had committed the robbery.

On January 21, 2015, detectives from the Vacaville Police Department arrested S-Menefee in the 800 block of Davis Street during a high risk stop. S-Menefee was arrested without incident and a search warrant was conducted of his residence. S-Menefee is being charged with robbery and was booked at Solano County Jail. VACAVILLE POLICE SEEK SUSPECT IN ARMED ROBBERY

On January 15, 2015 at approximately 3:45 p.m., Vacaville police received a telephone call from a victim who reported a south Vacaville business had been robbed. Officers responded to the scene while other officers searched for the suspect. The suspect was described as a light skinned black male adult, 20-30 years of age wearing a black knit cap and a black shirt with white writing on it. The suspect was seen with handgun in his waistband.

The suspect was seen running from the business towards Marshall Road and Ogden Way. The suspect was last seen running north on Ogden Way. Officers arrived in the area, established a perimeter and conducted a search for the suspect with a police canine. The suspect was not located and the business is cooperating with this investigation.
