LOJACK SYSTEM LEADS TO RECOVERY OF STOLEN VEHICLE, TWO SUSPECTS

A system designed to locate stolen vehicles worked better than expected when the stolen vehicle was found along with two suspects in the theft of the vehicle.

On January 25, 2015, at approximately 1:05 a.m., Vacaville police officers and the California Highway Patrol responded to a LoJack Stolen Vehicle Recovery System alert near Davis Street and I-80 East. Officers searched the area for a car that had been reported stolen within the last hour. Officers received a second alert near I-80 East and Allison Drive less than a minute later.

Officers located the stolen car on I-80 East passing Allison Drive and confirmed the car as stolen. Officers stopped the vehicle and arrested Melchor Jaimes Gutierrez, 33, and Filiberto Torres Zier, 42, both Fairfield residents. Gutierrez was found in possession of a shaved auto key, which he used to operate the stolen car. The suspects were booked into the Solano County Jail.
