Vacaville Police arrest man after striking a female in the face with the butt of a gun, then firing the gun in a dangerous manner.

At around 11:06 pm, Vacaville Police Communication Center began receiving numerous 9-1-1 calls regarding shots being fired in the area of the 1900 block of Aletha Lane. Information came into the dispatch center that a male had struck a female in the face with the butt of a handgun and then fired off 4-5 rounds in the air. The suspect, David Scott Kling 40 year old Fairfield resident was located by officers attempting to run from the scene and was detained. Upon being detained he tossed a loaded handgun on the ground next to where he was stopped.

The investigation showed there was a verbal argument between the Victim and Suspect over a parking spot, when the Suspect brandished the handgun and struck the victim with the gun. The suspect then fired off 4-5 rounds in the air as he fled the scene. The suspect was medically cleared at Vaca Valley Hospital for injuries that he sustained during the incident and booked into Solano County Jail.



The victim was treated at the scene by Vacaville Fire Personnel for a cut to her forehead.
