### **Narrative:**

On Sunday, July 26, 2015, at approximately 1:30pm, Vacaville Police Department Officers responded to the 300 block of Royal Oaks Drive after residents reported shots fired and a physical altercation occurring in the street. Initial information revealed that the parties involved had met to conduct a drug deal that led to a robbery of the victims' money. The suspect produced a firearm and fired at least one shot according to witnesses. Two victims suffered non-life threatening injuries and the suspect fled the scene prior to officers' arrival. Through further investigation, detectives learned the identity of the suspect.

On Tuesday, August 4, 2015, detectives conducted a high-risk stop on a vehicle at the corner of Tulare Drive & Southwood Drive. A 17-year-old Vacaville resident was taken into custody for his role in the shooting and was later booked into the Solano County Detention Center. Detectives also executed a search warrant in the 500 block of Greenwood Drive following the suspect's arrest.
