SOLO DUI CRASH RESULTS IN SERIOUS INJURIES TO PASSENGER

A Winters resident suffered major injuries Monday evening when the vehicle they were a passenger in crashed near the end of Crocker Drive in north Vacaville in an apparent DUI incident.

Shortly after 7:30 p.m. Vacaville police and fire personnel responded to a report of a solo vehicle that overturned at the end of Crocker Drive. First responders located a vehicle that had broken through wooden barriers and overturned in a dry creek bed. A photo of the accident is attached.

Rescuers located two occupants of the vehicle, one of whom sustained major non-life threatening injuries. The driver of the vehicle was identified as Eric Reyna-Najar, 31, of Vacaville. Reyna-Najar was believed to be under the influence of alcohol and he was ultimately arrested for DUI and DUI causing injury to another. Both occupants were transported to a nearby hospital for treatment of their injuries. Reyna-Najar was medically cleared and booked into the Solano County Jail.
