AGENCIES COLLABORATE TO ARREST MAJOR METH SUPPLIERS

A nearly year-long investigation led to the arrest of two Sacramento residents believed to major methamphetamine suppliers in Solano County.

The Vacaville Police Department Narcotic Enforcement Team (NET), along with the Vacaville Police Department Investigative Services Division, the Sacramento County Special Enforcement Detail (SED), and the Sacramento Police Department SWAT team executed four search warrants in the City and County of Sacramento on Thursday afternoon. This closed a 10-month investigation into the drug sales activities of Alfred Martinez, 41, and Crystal Lopez, 34, both of Sacramento. Previous investigation determined Martinez to be a major methamphetamine supplier into the Solano County area.




Upon execution of the warrants, detectives located methamphetamine, evidence of large-scale methamphetamine sales, handguns, high-capacity magazines, an illegal assault weapon, a short-barreled shotgun, approximately \$55,000 in drug proceeds and over \$7,000 in counterfeit U.S. currency. Additionally, the investigation proved that children were inside the McQuillen Circle home at the time that some of the drugs were used and sold.

Both Martinez and Lopez were arrested and booked into the Sacramento County Jail. Pictures of both suspects are included in this press release, along with some of the items recovered during the execution of the search warrants.
