INVESTIGATION LEADS TO ARREST OF TWO FAIRFIELD RESIDENTS

A year-long investigation ended Tuesday with the arrest of two Fairfield residents on a variety of drug, weapons and other charges.

The Vacaville Police Department Narcotics Enforcement Team (NET), along with personnel from the department's Crime Suppression Team (CST), conducted the investigation into the drug trafficking activities of Louis Latini, 48, of Fairfield. Investigators determined that Latini had been a major source of narcotics into the Fairfield and Vacaville areas.

At approximately 4:09 p.m. Tuesday, police executed a search warrant at a residence in the 2400 block of Beaufort Drive in Fairfield. Previous investigation determined this to be the residence address of Latini and Kelly Colby, 45, of Fairfield.

Upon execution of the warrant, detectives located a large amount of methamphetamine, cocaine and marijuana packaged for sale. Two firearms were also located in the residence, as well as evidence of drug sales including scales and packaging materials. At the time of his arrest, Latini was out on bail for a separate pending case.

After they were arrested, both Latini and Colby unsuccessfully attempted to destroy evidence which they had concealed on their person. Both were eventually booked into Solano County Jail without incident.




