TRIO ARRESTED NEAR SCHOOL ON VARIETY OF DRUG CHARGES

Three people were arrested Friday afternoon after a search warrant revealed a variety of drug and weapons violations were taking place at a residence near Kairos Academy in Vacaville.

At approximately 2:45 p.m. Friday, the Vacaville Police Department Narcotic Enforcement Team (NET), along with the Vacaville Police Department Crime Suppression Team (CST), executed a search warrant in the 400 block of Olive Street.

The investigation was collaboration between NET and concerned citizens in the area who had witnessed numerous narcotic violations occurring in their neighborhood. Upon execution of the warrant, detectives located marijuana, methamphetamine, butane honey oil, a .38 caliber revolver, and additional evidence of drug sales from the residence. Detectives also located butane honey oil extraction lab equipment, chemicals, and finished product. The residence where the warrant was executed was within 1,000 feet of Kairos Charter School on Elm Street.

Katherine Bailey, 45; Robert Mendoza, 37; and Candice Contreras, 42 were all arrested and booked into Solano County Jail on a variety of drug and weapons charges.

The Vacaville Police Department Narcotic Enforcement Team works in partnership with the citizens of Vacaville to enforce narcotic laws and regulations, and to arrest drug traffickers.
