COUPLE ARRESTED ON DRUG, WEAPONS AND OTHER CHARGES

A two-month-long investigation by Vacaville police ended Tuesday with the arrest of a local couple on drug sales and child endangerment charges.

The Vacaville Police Department Narcotic Enforcement Team (NET), along with personnel from the Crime Suppression Team (CST) and the Special Weapons and Tactics Team (SWAT), on Tuesday afternoon served a search warrant at an apartment in the 100 block of Aegean Way.

Upon execution of the warrant, detectives located approximately three ounces of heroin, methamphetamine, marijuana, scales, packaging materials, pay/owe sheets, and a loaded, .22 caliber revolver. Detectives discovered that the residents of the apartment had fortified their dwelling in an attempt to deter and keep law enforcement officers from entering. A 3-year-old child lives at the address but was with relatives at the time of the service of the warrant.


Police arrested Sean Kennedy, 27, of Vacaville along with Mariah Tipton, 22, also of Vacaville on a variety of drugs, weapons and other charges, including child endangerment. They were booked into Solano County Jail.


