DUI Saturation Patrol Nets 3 Arrests

Vacaville, CA – The Vacaville Police Department Traffic Unit was scheduled to conduct a DUI/Drivers License Checkpoint on Saturday, January 4. However, due to staffing conflicts, a DUI Saturation Patrol was conducted instead between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and midnight in areas with high frequencies of DUI collisions and/or arrests throughout the City in an effort to stop and arrest alcohol and drug-impaired drivers in the Department's ongoing traffic safety campaign.

The results of this saturation were:

- 57 vehicles stopped
- Five drivers evaluated for impairment
- Three drivers cited/arrested for operating a vehicle unlicensed or while suspended/revoked (1 driver also arrested for an outstanding warrant)
- 10 Citations issued

The Vacaville Police Department will be conducting additional DUI/Drivers License Checkpoints or DUI Saturation Patrols in the near future (more information to follow) in our ongoing commitment to lowering deaths and injuries upon our streets and highways.
