FAIRFIELD TRIO ARRESTED ON A VARIETY OF DRUG-RELATED CHARGES

Service of a search warrant by Vacaville police Tuesday afternoon arrested led to the arrest of three Fairfield residents on a variety of drug-related charges.

Detectives from the Vacaville Police Department Narcotic Enforcement Team as well as the Crime Suppression Team executed a search warrant in the 2200 block of Cement Hill Road in Fairfield Tuesday at around 2:30 p.m. Previous investigation determined this to be the residence of Jeffrey Todd Gerlacher, 47, and Julie Marie Bilka, 48, both of Fairfield, who were suspected of drug sales and other drug-related activities.

Upon execution of the warrant, both Gerlacher and Bilka were detained and a search conducted of the residence. Detectives located over three ounces of methamphetamine; scales; and other evidence of drug sales at the residence as well as on Gerlacher's and Bilka's person. Additionally, detectives seized over \$12,000 in drug proceeds from the residence.

During the search of the residence, Bruce Hoover, 52, of Fairfield was located in the residence and was found to be in possession of drug paraphernalia.

All three subjects (photos attached) were arrested and transported to Solano County Jail.
